**TO: Randy Corbett, 9055 SW Blake Street, Turlin, OR 97062-9023**

Insurance Commissioner Jon Godfread ("Commissioner") has determined as follows:

1. As a result of information obtained by the North Dakota Insurance Department ("Department") regarding the conduct of Randy Corbett, NPN 17940447 ("Respondent"), the Commissioner has considered scheduling a formal hearing to determine whether Respondent's conduct as alleged constitutes a basis for imposition of a civil penalty or any other action the Commissioner deems necessary. As more fully described below, Respondent's conduct is alleged to be in violation of N.D.C.C. § 26.1-26-15.

2. N.D.C.C. § 26.1-26-15 states, in part:

**26.1-26-15. License requirement - Character.**

An applicant for any license under this chapter must be deemed by the commissioner to be competent, trustworthy, financially responsible, and of good personal and business reputation. If the commissioner does not deem an applicant to be competent, trustworthy, financially responsible, of good personal reputation, or of good business reputation, the commissioner may deny the application for licensure.

3. Respondent has been licensed as a nonresident insurance producer in North Dakota since June 29, 2016.

4. On or about July 10, 2017, Respondent uploaded documents regarding a criminal conviction. A background investigation revealed that on or about June 20, 2017, Respondent pled guilty to misdemeanor assault and was sentenced to 24 months of supervised probation.

5. Respondent's actions constitute a violation of N.D.C.C. § 26.1-26-15.

6. Respondent acknowledges that at the time of signing the Consent to Entry of Order, he was aware of or had been advised of the right to a hearing in this matter, to consult an attorney, to present argument to the Commissioner, to appeal from any adverse determination after a hearing, and Respondent expressly waives those rights.

7. Respondent has agreed to informal disposition of this matter, without a hearing, as provided under N.D.C.C. § 28-32-22.


8. For purposes of resolving this matter without further administrative proceedings, Respondent has agreed to enter into the following order.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Respondent agrees to a conditional license, to run concurrently with the criminal probationary period, from June 20, 2017 to June 20, 2019.

2. The use of this Consent Order for competitive purposes by an insurance agent or agency holding a license in the State of North Dakota, or by any company holding a Certificate of Authority, or by anyone on their behalf, may be deemed unfair competition and be grounds for suspension or revocation of said license or authority.
